## Student Dress Code



### **Camper Dress Standards:**

1. Campers hair will be clean and well-groomed at all times and shall not obstruct vision.
2. Campers must wear shoes at all times except as may be required during certain physical activities.
3. Campers are not to bring any head apparel.
4. Campers may not wear midriff-type apparel. Skirts and shorts must not be shorter than the student's extended fingertips. Divided skirts, hemmed above the knee, are considered shorts. No spaghetti straps, tank tops or visible under clothing permitted. All tops must cover the entire shoulder.
5. Proper under garments must be worn and not visible.
6. Campers may not wear slogan buttons or clothing with inappropriate or violent slogans or advertising. An example would be an alcohol advertisement.
7. Any attire related to negative group behavior (gangs, etc.) will not be permitted.
8. Camper dress for social functions will be announced prior to camp.
9. Earrings may be worn in the ear only, No other body piercing will be permitted.
10. Chains are not allowed.
11. No oversized pants or sweats are permitted.
12. Pants/shorts/shirts/skorts will be worn on the waist above the point of the hip.
14. Any distraction due to dress will be dealt with on an individual basis.

**If a camper is found to be in violation of the dress code policy and resists a change into acceptable attire, the camp director will call camper's parents and arrange immediate pick-up.**
